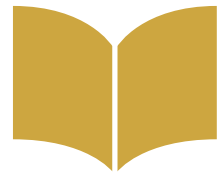
Welcome to Utopia

Feeling Safe



Physical Contact

Child to child physical contact: Keep physical contact to a minimum i.e. sports games, greetings and goodbyes, helping someone up.



Safe Spaces: The calm room is a safe space for pupils to support regulation.



Safe Spaces: Use of identified, independent work areas and safe spaces are risk assessed and agreed with pupil, school and parent/carer.



Tips talking to a trusted adult

Choose someone you feel safe with:

- Parent, carer, or someone else in your family
- Teacher, sports coach or a member of staff at your school
- Doctor, school nurse or a school counsellor
- Religious leader, for example a priest, imam or rabbi.

Plan what you want to say

"I want to tell you something but I don't know how."

"This is hard for me to say, but I have something important to tell you."

"I need some advice on something I'm stressed about."



British Values



At Utopia we will support you to:

Spiritually

- Recognise the impact of yours and others' feelings.
- Understand how creative experiences can have a positive impact on your life.
- Be reflective about your own beliefs, values and ideas.
- Show persistence and help others to do so in a sensitive way.

Morally

- Make reasoned judgements on moral dilemmas and where to get help.
- Act confidently to you own principles and able to explain these to others.
- Lead a considerate style of life and explain what this means.
- Sensitively deal with other people's lack of respect.

Socially

- Show interest in and explain how diverse communities an societies function.
- Reflect on your own contribution to society and the world of work.
- Understand where it might be ok to ask for advice.
- Explain rights and responsibilities across different cultures and backgrounds.

Culturally

- Explain how cultural influences shape people's heritage.
- Explain how 'emerging world of shared culture' is changing communities.
- Sensitively challenge others whose behaviour has an impact on minorities.
- Understand how a range of influences shape Britain's fundamental values.
